

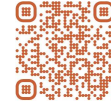

The Queen West Art Crawl (QWAC) is a community-based arts & culture organization dedicated to supporting the arts community in Queen West and across Toronto. Our signature event is a two-day multidisciplinary arts festival that takes place in Trinity Bellwoods Park. The festival brings in thousands of visitors each year and is a true celebration of Toronto's vibrant arts community.

The Queen West Art Crawl would like to acknowledge this sacred land on which we gather and operate is the traditional territory of the Wendat and Petun First Nations, The Seneca, the Mississaugas of the Credit River, and any other nations who cared for the land in its history - recorded and unrecorded. The territory is the subject of the Dish With One Spoon Wampum Belt Covenant, an agreement between the Haudenosaunee Confederacy and Confederacy of the Ojibwe and allied nations to peacefully share and care for the resources around the Great Lakes. Today, the meeting place of Toronto is still the home to many indigenous people from across Turtle Island and we are grateful to work in the community, on this territory.

Using visual reference and examples the kids can make their own mixed media inspired art using sustainable materials and various art.



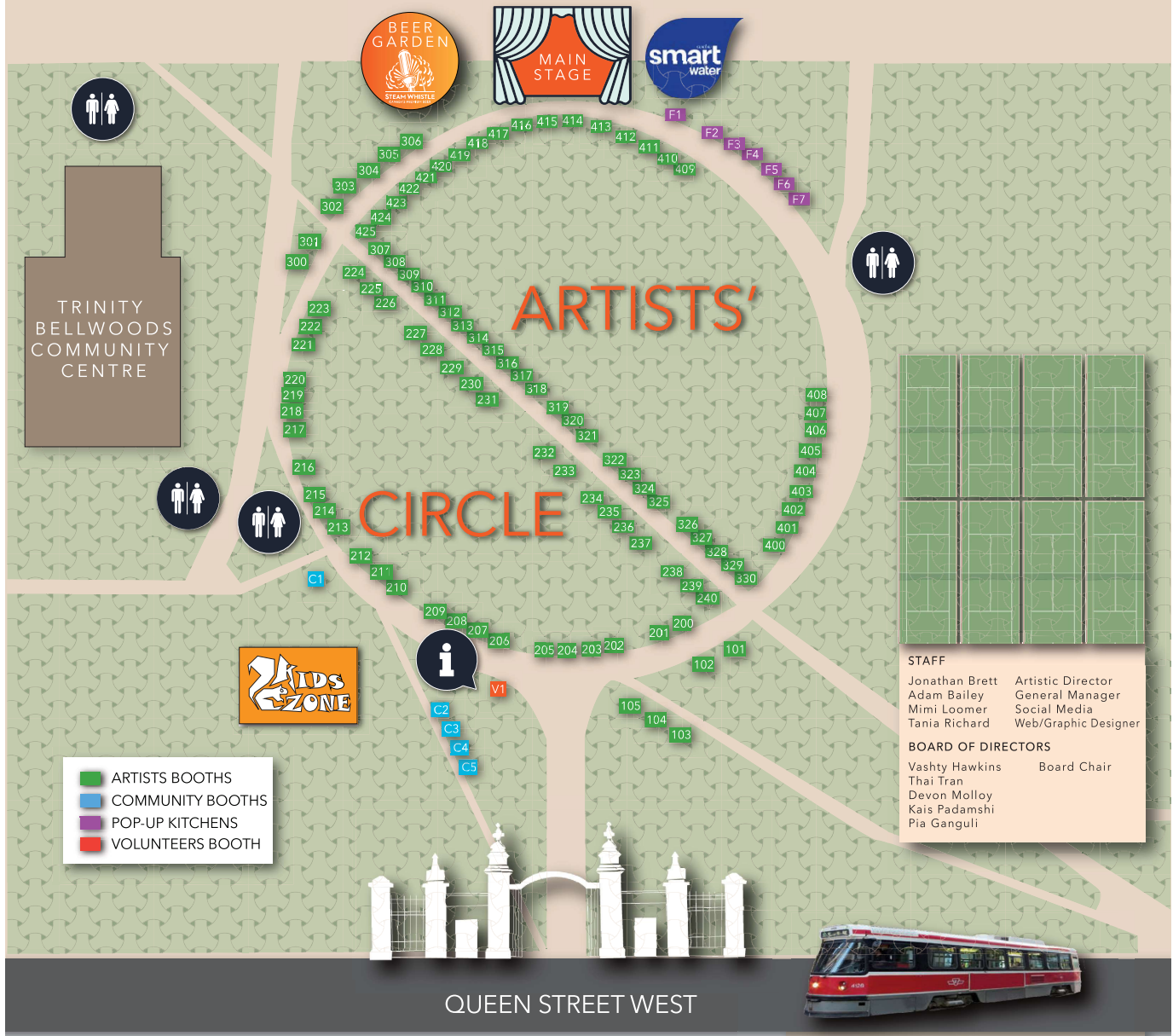

**Ontario Culture Featured Artists Booth 101**  
Creative in Residence **Alisa McDonald** is a contemporary textile artist who experiments with themes of folklore, fables and the esoteric. For her residency, Alisa created colourful, needle-punched "weirdos" that live in the ironic pop-culture paradise of a Queer GenX Feminist. During the #ONCultureDays Festival, these wall hangings will be exhibited at the Toronto Public Library Reference Library and the Guelph Civic Museum. Join McDonald in the Ontario Culture Days booth at the Queen West Art Crawl to learn the art of punch-needling and to contribute to a collaborative art piece.

Introducing Creative in Residence **Owen Marshall**, an artist and printmaker who examines the way text and signage influence the surrounding environment, as well as the humour that emerges when the perceived authority of signs is undermined or challenged. For his project "Six and a Half Flags over Queen Street West," Marshall will place printed flags on flagpoles in the park with guided tours from booth 101 #ONCultureDays.
